**The Alderney (Application of Legislation)  
(Supplementary Benefit) (Amendment)  
Ordinance, 1971**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the thirtieth day of June, nineteen hundred and seventy-one, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section one of the Alderney (Application of Legislation) Law, 1948(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:—

1. The Supplementary Benefit (Implementation) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1971(b), shall have effect in the Island of Alderney as it has effect in the Island of Guernsey.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Alderney (Application of Legislation) (Supplementary Benefit) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1971.
