**The Alderney (Application of Legislation)
(Supplementary Benefit) Ordinance, 1977**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the thirtieth day of March, nineteen hundred and seventy-seven, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section one of the Alderney (Application of Legislation) Law, 1948(a), hereby order:—

1. The Supplementary Benefit (Implementation) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1977(b), shall have effect in the Island of Alderney as it has effect in the Island of Guernsey. Ordinance to have effect in Alderney.

2. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Alderney (Application of Legislation) (Supplementary Benefit) Ordinance, 1977. Citation and commencement.

(2) This Ordinance shall come into force on the twenty-seventh day of May, nineteen hundred and seventy-seven.
