**The Alderney (Application of Legislation)
(Supplementary Benefit) Ordinance, 1978**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-first day of June, nineteen hundred and seventy-eight, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section one of the Alderney (Application of Legislation) Law, 1948(a), hereby order:—

1. The Supplementary Benefit (Implementation) Ordinance to have effect in Alderney. (Amendment) Ordinance, 1978(b), shall have effect in the Island of Alderney as it has effect in the Island of Guernsey.

2. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Alderney Citation and commencement. (Application of Legislation) (Supplementary Benefit) Ordinance, 1978.

(2) This Ordinance shall come into force on the twenty-fourth day of November, nineteen hundred and seventy-eight.
