**The Alderney (Application of Legislation)
(Teachers' Superannuation)
(Family Benefits) Ordinance, 1967**

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by the Alderney (Application of Legislation) Law, 1948, hereby order:—

1. The Teachers' Superannuation (Family Benefits) (Guernsey) Law, 1967, and the Teachers' Superannuation (Family Benefits) Ordinance, 1967, shall have effect in the Island of Alderney as they have effect in the Island of Guernsey: Legislation to have effect in Alderney.
Provided that for the word "Guernsey" in the definition of the expression "reckonable service" in subsection (1) of section one of the said Ordinance there shall be substituted the word "Alderney".

2. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Alderney (Application of Legislation) (Teachers' Superannuation) (Family Benefits) Ordinance, 1967.

(2) This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into force on the first day of April, nineteen hundred and sixty-seven.
