**“The Alderney (Application of Legislation)  
(Water Laws) Ordinance, 1950.”**

THE STATES, under and by virtue of the powers in that behalf conferred on them by the Alderney (Application of Legislation) Law, 1948, and on the representations of the States Water Board, hereby order:—

1. The words “The reference to the 10th day of May, 1938, shall be deemed to be a reference to the 31st day of December, 1948,” which occur in the second column of Part VI of the First Schedule to the Alderney (Application of Legislation) Ordinance, 1948, immediately opposite the words “States Water Supply (Temporary Provisions) Law, 1938.” which occur in the first column of Part VI of the said First Schedule, shall be deleted. Amendment of 1948 Ordinance.
2. The States Water Supply (Temporary Provisions) Amendment Law, 1949, shall have effect in the Island of Alderney. 1949 Law to have effect in Alderney.
3. This Ordinance shall come into force on the fifteenth day of February, 1950. Commencement.
