**The Alderney (Application of Legislation)
Amendment Ordinance, 1951.**

THE STATES, under and by virtue of the powers in that behalf conferred upon them by the Alderney (Application of Legislation) Law, 1948, hereby order:—

1. The second column of Part II of the First Schedule to the Alderney (Application of Legislation) Ordinance, 1948, (hereinafter called "the Principal Ordinance") shall be amended by the insertion, immediately following the substitution of a sub-section in lieu of sub-section (7) of section seven of the first Law set out in the first column of the said Part II of the said Schedule, of the following modification of the said section seven—

In sub-section (10) of section seven the words "one year" shall be substituted for the words "three years".

2. This Ordinance and the Principal Ordinance may be cited together as the Alderney (Application of Legislation) Ordinances, 1948 and 1951.

3. This Ordinance shall come into force on the 21st day of March, 1951.
