The Alderney Control of Fishing etc. Ordinance, 1957

THE STATES, upon the advice of the Committee for Agriculture and Fisheries have made the following Regulations which shall come into force on September 4th, 1957.

Ormers.

1. (a) The close season for Ormers shall be from May 1st to September 15th each year, both days included. It shall be an offence for any person to take or be in possession of ormers during this period.

NOTES

In section 1, paragraph (b) was repealed by the Fishing (Alderney) Ordinance, 1967, section 6, with effect from 20th July, 1967.

In accordance with their Resolution of 15th January, 1997 on Article VI of the Billet d'État of that date, the States of Alderney resolved that the mandate of the States of Alderney General Services Committee should include, inter alia, being, for the purposes of all legislation, the States Committee for Agriculture and Fisheries and performing the functions, inter alia, of being responsible for all matters relating to sea fisheries and administering this Ordinance.

Size of fish that may be taken.

2. No person shall in Alderney land, sell, expose or offer for sale, or have in his possession for the purpose of sale any fish named in the Schedule annexed hereto of less than the dimensions given in the said Schedule against each

respectively.

Sections 3-4.

4. The Ordinance entitled "The Alderney Fishing etc. Control Ordinance, 1951" is hereby repealed.

NOTES

Section 3 was repealed by the Fishing (Alderney) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1980, section 9, with effect from 6th March, 1980.

The Ordinance was made on 3rd September, 1957 and came into operation on 4th September, 1957.
