ORDINANCE OF THE STATES

Made 28th April, 1952
Coming into force 30th April, 1952

THE ALDERNEY FISHING ETC., CONTROL
ORDINANCE, 1952

In pursuance of the Resolution dated May 16th, 1951, the States, upon the advice of the States Committee for Agriculture and Fisheries, have made the following regulations which shall come into force on April 30th, 1952.

1. Ormers:

The close season for Ormers shall be from May 1st to September 15th of each year, both days included. It shall be an offence for any person to take or be in possession of Ormers during this period.

2. Nets:

It shall be an offence for any person to use in any of the bays upon the coast of the Island of Alderney stop nets the mesh of which measures less than three inches.

3. Size of Fish:

It shall be an offence for any person to sell fish of the following species having dimensions respectively less than those shown against them:-

Sole and Plaice	8 inches long
Turbot and Brill	10 inches long
Rays	12 inches long
Lobsters	8 inches long
Crabs	5½ inches in diameter
Ormers	3 inches in diameter
Lady Crabs	2 inches in diameter

4. A person committing an offence against any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall upon conviction be liable to a fine not exceeding Ten Pounds.
