**THE ALDERNEY LIQUOR LICENSING
(AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1980**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of nineteen hundred and eighty, hereby order:-

Amendments to Ordinance of 1966.

1. The Alderney Liquor Licensing Ordinance, 1966, as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:-

- (a) in section fifteen thereof the words "ten shillings" are repealed and the words "twenty five pounds" are substituted therefor;
- (b) In subsection (1) of section sixteen thereof all the words after the words "annual fee which shall be - " are repealed and the following words are substituted therefor:-

- "(i) for an hotel licence, forty pounds;
- (ii) for a public house licence, thirty pounds;
- (iii) for a restaurant licence, thirty pounds; and
- (iv) for a club licence, twenty pounds."

Citation.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Alderney Liquor Licensing (Amendment) Ordinance, 1980.

Collective Title.

3. This Ordinance and the Alderney Liquor Licensing Ordinances 1966 to 1977, may be cited together as the Alderney Liquor Licensing Ordinances 1966 to 1980.

Commencement.

4. This Ordinance shall come into force on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and eighty one.
