THE ALDERNEY LIQUOR LICENSING (AMENDMENT)
ORDINANCE, 1989

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 15th December, 1989, hereby order:-

Amendment to Ordinance of 1966 to 1977

1. The Alderney Liquor Licensing Ordinances, 1966 to 1977, are hereby further amended by inserting the following section after 37:-

"Noise on licensed premises:

37A(1) A licensee, his agent or servant shall not cause or permit any excessive noise to emanate from the licensed premises for which the licensee holds the liquor licence.

(2) Any person who contravenes the provisions of this section shall be guilty of an offence punishable on conviction with a fine not exceeding level 4 on the uniform scale."

Citation and collective title

2.(1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Alderney Liquor Licensing (Amendment) Ordinance, 1989.

(2) This Ordinance and the Alderney Liquor Licensing Ordinances, 1966 to 1977 may be cited together as the Alderney Liquor Licensing Ordinances, 1966 to 1989.
