## THE ALDERNEY LIQUOR LICENSING (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1999

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 3rd day of March, 1999,  
hereby order:—

1. In The Alderney Liquor Licensing Ordinance, 1994:—

**Amendment  
of Ordinance  
of 1994.**

- (a) in section 15(8) after the words "The Court shall"  
insert ",subject to the provisions of subsection  
(8A),";
- (b) after section 15(8) insert the following  
subsections:—

"(8A) The Court shall not consider any  
objection under this section to the renewal of a  
liquor licence, other than an objection made by the  
Chief Officer of Police or the Medical Officer of  
Health, unless, at least 21 days prior to the date on  
which the application for the renewal is proposed  
to be made, the objector delivers to the Clerk of the  
Court a written notice specifying the nature and  
terms of his objection together with:—

2. This Ordinance may be cited as The Alderney Liquor Citation.

(a) an explanation of his objection sufficient to enable a reasonable person to understand the essence of it; and

(b) a statement of the material facts upon which the objector relies, but not the evidence by which those facts are to be proved.

(8B) Immediately upon receipt of the notice provided for in subsection (8A), the Clerk of the Court shall:-

(a) cause a copy of the notice to be fixed on the notice board outside the Court House until the day of the application; and

(b) deliver a copy of the notice to the applicant.”;

(c) for the First Schedule substitute the schedule set out in the schedule to this Ordinance;

(d) for Part III of the Second Schedule substitute the following:-

“Part III

Restaurant Licences

**Warning.**

No person shall consume any intoxicating liquor on these premises unless seated at a table consuming a meal and except:-

(a) during the hours of 10.00 a.m. to midnight (during the period 1st October to 31st March); or

(b) during the hours of 10.00 a.m. to 12.30 a.m. the next day (during the period 1st April to 30th September).

PENALTY £500.”.
