THE ALDERNEY OCCUPIERS' RATE ORDINANCE, 1949

In pursuance of the powers accorded to the States of Alderney by Article 3 of the Alderney (Application of Legislation) Law, 1948, which provides that an Occupiers' rate shall be levied on or after January 1<sup>st</sup>, 1949, in each calendar year, for the purpose of financing the Services for which the States of Alderney continue to remain responsible under that Law -

The following Ordinance is therefore made for the purpose of declaring the incidence of the Occupiers' Rate and providing for the collection thereof:

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Alderney Occupiers' Rate Ordinance, 1949.
2. Rateable value shall mean the Rateable Value assessed and recorded in the General Cadastre of the Island.
3. The Occupiers' Rate shall be levied upon the Rateable Value at the rate calculated from year to year in the manner laid down in Article 3 of the Alderney (Application of Legislation) Law, 1948.
4. When an assessment has become final, the States Treasurer shall, as soon as may be, issue a notice to the person assessed, showing the amount and the property upon which it is due and the date of issue. The notice will also state that in case of payment not having been made within 14 days of the date of issue, legal action in the Court of Alderney will be taken for the recovery of the amount due, and that the assessee may also be liable for the costs of such legal action.
