**The Alderney Rateable Values  
Assessment (Amendment) Ordinance, 1973**

THE STATES, on the representations of the States Cadastre Committee and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section four of the Alderney (Application of Legislation) Law, 1948(a), hereby order:—

1. The Alderney Rateable Values Assessment Ordinance, 1949(b), is hereby amended as follows:— Amendments to Ordinance of 1949.

- (a) the full stop at the end of section one thereof is deleted and a colon and the following proviso are substituted therefor:—

“Provided that, without prejudice to the validity of any rectification, notice of any such rectification shall be sent to the owner, the usufructuary (if any) and the occupier (if any) of the property concerned by means

of a letter delivered or sent by post to such owner, usufructuary and occupier as the case may be at his address as recorded in the Cadastre.”;

- (b) in subsection (1) of section seven thereof all the words beginning with the words “six consecutive working days” to the end of that subsection are repealed and the following words are substituted therefor:—

“five consecutive working days throughout the normal working hours of that office.”.

2. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Alderney Rateable Values Assessment (Amendment) Ordinance, 1973.

(2) This Ordinance and the Alderney Rateable Values Assessment Ordinance, 1949, may be cited together as the Alderney Rateable Values Assessment Ordinances, 1949 and 1973.
