ARRANGEMENT OF SECTIONS

1-3. Sections 1-3.

(Made on the 4th September, 1956.)

The Alderney Slot Machine (Prohibition of Gambling) Ordinance, 1956

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution dated 4th September, 1956, hereby order: –

Sections 1-3.

1. A person may not set up and expose for use by other persons any slot machine or other mechanical or automatic device the action of which is controlled by the insertion of a coin or token, otherwise than for the purpose of the purchase of an ascertained article of service or value.

2. A person who contravenes the provisions of this Ordinance shall upon conviction be liable to a fine not exceeding [level 1 on the Alderney uniform scale] or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding one month or to both such fine and such imprisonment and the Court may order the confiscation of the device.

3. This Ordinance shall come into force on the 13th November, 1956.

NOTE

In this Ordinance, the words and figure in square brackets in section 2 were substituted by the Uniform Scale of Fines (Alderney) Law, 1989, section 2(2), with effect from 1st October, 1989.
