**The Alderney Water Supply (Transfer
of Functions) Ordinance, 1955**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 7th day of April, 1954, and by virtue of the powers conferred on them by the Alderney (Application of Legislation) Law, 1948, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:—

1. So much of Part VI of the First Schedule of the Alderney (Application of Legislation) Ordinance, 1948, as remains unrepealed is hereby repealed.
2. The Alderney (Application of Legislation) (Water Laws) Ordinance, 1950, is hereby repealed and the Waterworks Byelaws (Amendment) Ordinance, 1954, shall cease to have effect in the Island of Alderney.
3. This Ordinance shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey and Alderney.
4. This Ordinance shall come into force on the 25th day of March, 1955.
