### **The August Bank Holiday Ordinance, 1965**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-ninth day of July, nineteen hundred and sixty-four, hereby order:—

1. The last Monday in August, nineteen hundred and sixty-five, shall be a bank holiday instead of the first Monday in that month.

Last Monday in August, 1965, declared a bank holiday.

2. The references in—

- (a) Article 1 of the Ordinance entitled “Ordonnance contenant les Règlements pour le Greffe” of the twenty-fifth day of October, nineteen hundred and thirty(a);
- (b) paragraph (2) of section two of the Registry of Deaths Ordinance, 1949(b);
- (c) paragraph (e) of section two of the Bank Holidays and Negotiable Instruments (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1955(c);

References in certain Ordinances to the first Monday in August to be construed, as respects 1965, as references to the last Monday in that month.

Extent.       3. This Ordinance shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Herm and Jethou.

Citation.      4. This Ordinance may be cited as the August Bank Holiday Ordinance, 1965.
