ORDINANCE OF THE STATES

Made 2nd March, 1988
Coming into force 2nd March, 1988

THE BANK HOLIDAYS (ALDERNEY) ORDINANCE, 1988

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the second day of March, 1988 and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 46 of, and paragraph (o) of Schedule 2 to, the Government of Alderney Law, 1987(a), hereby order:-

Bank holidays.

- 1, The following are bank holidays in Alderney -
 - (a) 1st January, or, if that day is a Sunday, 2nd January;
 - (b) Easter Monday;
 - (c) the first Monday in May;
 - (d) the last Monday in May;
 - (e) the first Monday in August;
 - (f) 26th December, unless that day is a Sunday;
 - (g) if either 25th or 26th December is a Sunday, 27th December.

Repeals.

2. The August Bank Holiday (Alderney) Ordinance, 1968 and the May Bank holiday (Alderney) Ordinance, 1980 are repealed.
