**The Bank Holidays (Amendment)
(Guernsey) Ordinance, 1976**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the sixteenth day of December, nineteen hundred and seventy-six, hereby order:—

1. For the First Schedule to the Bank Holidays (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1976(a) (hereafter in this Ordinance referred to as "the principal Ordinance"), there is hereby substituted the Schedule set out in the Schedule to this Ordinance. Amendment of principal Ordinance.

2. (1) Subsection (2) of section one of the Registry of Deaths (Opening Hours) Ordinance, 1968, is hereby repealed and the following subsection is hereby substituted therefor— Consequential amendments.

“ (2) On each of the days for the time being specified in subsection (1) of section one of the Bank Holidays (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1976, or in the First Schedule thereto, the Registry of Deaths shall close at ten o'clock in the forenoon. ”

(2) In paragraph (1) of Article 1 of the Ordinance entitled "Ordonnance contenant les Règlements pour le Greffe" of the twenty-fifth day of October, nineteen hundred and thirty, as amended (hereafter in this section referred to as "the Ordinance of 1930"), for the words and figures "la section deux de l'Ordonnance intitulée "The Bank Holidays and Negotiable Instruments (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1955" there are hereby substituted the words "la première section de l'Ordonnance intitulée "The Bank Holidays (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1976" ou dans la Première Cédule à la dite Ordonnance".

(3) Paragraph (1) of Article 1 of the Ordinance of 1930, as further amended by this Ordinance, shall have effect as if there were included therein, immediately after the reference to Good Friday, references to the twenty-eighth day of December, nineteen hundred and seventy-six, and to the third day of January, nineteen hundred and seventy-seven.

Extent.

3. This Ordinance shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Herm and Jethou.

Citation.

4. This Ordinance may be cited as the Bank Holidays (Amendment) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1976.
