**The Bank Holidays (Amendment)
(Guernsey) Ordinance, 1980**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-eighth day of February, nineteen hundred and eighty, hereby order:—

1. Section one of the Bank Holidays (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1979, as amended (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Ordinance”)(a) is hereby repealed and the following section is hereby substituted therefor:—

“1. The following days shall be bank holidays, that is to say:—

- (a) New Year’s Day if a weekday;
- (b) the second day of January in any year on which New Year’s Day falls on a Sunday;
- (c) Easter Monday;
- (d) the first Monday in May;
- (e) Liberation Day;

(a) No. VI of 1979; No. XXXI of 1979.

- (f) the last Monday in May;
- (g) the last Monday in August;
- (h) the twenty-sixth day of December if a week-day;
- (i) the twenty-seventh day of December in any year on which Christmas Day falls on a Sunday;
- (j) the twenty-seventh day of December in any year in which the twenty-sixth day of December falls on a Sunday. ”

Extent. 2. This Ordinance shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Herm and Jethou.

Citation and collective title. 3. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Bank Holidays (Amendment) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1980.

(2) This Ordinance and the principal Ordinance may be cited together as the Bank Holidays (Guernsey) Ordinances, 1979 and 1980.
