**The Bank Holidays (Amendment)  
(Guernsey) Ordinance, 1981**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the first day of October, nineteen hundred and eighty-one, hereby order:—

1. (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of the Bank Holidays (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1979, as amended<sup>(a)</sup>, the twenty-sixth day of December, nineteen hundred and eighty-one, shall not be a bank holiday. 28th December, 1981 to be a bank holiday.

(2) The twenty-eighth day of December, nineteen hundred and eighty-one, shall be a bank holiday.

2. This Ordinance shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Herm and Jethou. Extent.

3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Bank Holidays (Amendment) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1981. Citation.
