**The Bank Holidays (Amendment)
(Guernsey) Ordinance, 1989**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 26th day of January, 1989, hereby order:—

1. Section 1 of the Bank Holidays (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1979, as amended^(a), is hereby renumbered as section 1(1) and immediately thereafter there is hereby inserted the following additional subsection numbered “(2)”—

“ (2) In addition to the days specified in the last preceding subsection as bank holidays, the 23rd day of May, 1989, being the occasion of a visit to this Island of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth the Second and His Royal Highness The Prince Philip, Duke of Edinburgh, shall be a bank holiday.”

Extent. 2. This Ordinance shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Herm and Jethou.

Citation. 3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Bank Holidays (Amendment) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1989.
