**The Bank Holidays (Guernsey)  
Ordinance, 1976**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-eighth day of October, nineteen hundred and seventy-six, hereby order:—

1. (1) The following days shall be bank holidays, **Bank holidays.**  
that is to say:—
- (a) New Year's Day if a weekday;
  - (b) Easter Monday;
  - (c) Liberation Day;
  - (d) the twenty-sixth day of December if a weekday;
  - (e) the twenty-seventh day of December in any year in which Christmas Day falls on a Sunday;
  - (f) the twenty-seventh day of December in any year in which the twenty-sixth day of December falls on a Sunday;
  - (g) the second day of January in any year in which New Year's Day falls on a Sunday.

(2) In addition to the days specified in the last preceding subsection as bank holidays, the days in the years specified in the First Schedule to this Ordinance shall be bank holidays.

**Repeals.**

2. The Ordinances set out in the left hand column of the Second Schedule to this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent set out in the right hand column of that Schedule.

**Extent.**

3. This Ordinance shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Herm and Jethou.

**Citation.**

4. This Ordinance may be cited as the Bank Holidays (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1976.

## FIRST SCHEDULE Section 1 (2)

*Additional bank holidays in 1976, 1977 and 1978*

1976

The 28th day of December.

1977

The 3rd day of January.

The 6th day of June.

The 7th day of June, being the occasion of the celebration of the Silver Jubilee of the Accession to the Throne of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth the Second.

The 29th day of August.

1978

The 29th day of May.

The 28th day of August.
