The Bar Ordinance, 1976

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-eighth day of January, nineteen hundred and seventy-six, hereby order:—

1. The Disciplinary Committee (gallicized “La Chambre de Discipline”) of the Bar shall, in the event of the absence of Her Majesty’s Procureur and Her Majesty’s Comptroller or of their inability to act at any meeting thereof, consist of the two Advocates of the Royal Court appointed thereto in pursuance of the provisions of Article 5 of the Ordinance entitled “Ordonnance relative au Barreau et au Corps des Ecrivains” and made permanent on the eighteenth day of January, nineteen hundred and thirty-two^(a) (hereafter in this Ordinance referred to as “the Ordinance of 1932”), and an Advocate of the Royal Court appointed by the Bailiff for the purposes of that meeting, who shall act as chairman.
