The Bar Ordinance, 1984

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 29th day of February, 1984, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:—

1. The Bar Ordinance, 1949 (hereinafter referred as “the 1949 Ordinance”)(a) is amended as follows, that is to say:— Amendment to Ordinance of 1949.

- (a) in section 3(1)(b)(i) thereof the words “a certificate of the Law Society of England stating that he has passed the final examination of that Society” are repealed and the words “a certificate stating that he has been admitted as a Solicitor of the Supreme Court of Judicature in England” are substituted therefor;

(b) in section 3(1)(b)(ii) thereof the words “of the Law Society of England” are repealed.

Citation and collective title. 2. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Bar Ordinance, 1984.

(2) This Ordinance, the Ordinance entitled ‘Ordonnance relative au Barreau et au Corps des Ecrivains’ made permanent on the 18th day of January, 1932(b), the 1949 Ordinance and the Ordinance entitled “the Bar Ordinance, 1976” of the 26th day of February, 1976(c), may be cited together as the Bar Ordinances, 1932 to 1984.
