1991

Made 28th February, 1991.
Coming into Operation 1st March, 1991.

**The Births, Deaths and Marriages (Fees)
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1991**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 1st day of November, 1990(a), and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 3 of the Marriage (Amendment) Law, 1951(b) and by section 3A of the Births, Deaths and Marriages Certificates (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Guernsey) Law, 1951, as amended(c), hereby order:—

Increase of fees for marriage

1. In the Marriage Fees (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1978(d)—
 - (a) for the words “fifty new pence” in section 2, substitute “£1.50”; and
 - (b) for the Schedule thereto, substitute the Schedule set out in the Schedule to this Ordinance.

Increase of fees for certificates

2. In the Births, Deaths and Marriages Certificates (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Guernsey) Law, 1951, as amended—

- (a) for the words in section 1(2) from “seventy-five new pence” to the end there is substituted “three pounds”, and
- (b) for the words in sections 1(3), 2 and 3 from “one pound and fifty new pence” to the end in each case there is substituted “five pounds.”.

Citation

3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Births, Deaths and Marriages (Fees) Amendment Ordinance, 1991.

Commencement

4. This Ordinance shall come into force on the 1st March, 1991.
