**The Boats and Vessels (Registration,
Speed Limits and Abatement of Noise)
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1974**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolutions of the twenty-fifth day of October, nineteen hundred and seventy-two, and of the thirtieth day of January, nineteen hundred and seventy-four, hereby order:—

1. The Boats and Vessels (Registration, Speed Limits and Abatement of Noise) Ordinance, 1970 (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Ordinance”)(a) is hereby amended as follows:—

- (a) in section fourteen thereof the words “who is not ordinarily resident in the Islands of Guernsey, Herm or Jethou” are repealed;
- (b) in the definition of the expression “speed-boat” in subsection (1) of section eighteen thereof the word “twelve” is repealed and the word “seventeen” is substituted therefor.
