Ordinance of the Chief Pleas
entitled

The Bovine Animal Diseases (Amendment) (Sark) Ordinance, 1978

THE CHIEF PLEAS OF SARK, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by subsection (1) of section eight of the Reform (Sark) Law, 1951(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:-

1. The Brucellosis (Sark) Ordinance, 1971, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance"), is hereby amended as follows:-

(a) in section one thereof -

(i) the definition of the expression "the disease" is repealed and the following definition is substituted therefor -

" "the disease" means any of the following diseases -

Brucellosis (brucella abortus);

Bovine Tuberculosis; "

(ii) the definition of the expression "test" is repealed and the following definition is substituted therefor -

" "test" means -

(a) in relation to Brucellosis, the brucella abortus agglutination blood test;

(b) in relation to Bovine Tuberculosis, the single intradermal tuberculin test;

and any other test for any such

disease which may from time to time
be approved by the Committee and the
expression "tested" shall be construed
accordingly; "

- (b) section eight thereof is renumbered as section
"8.(1)" and immediately thereafter there is inserted
the following additional subsection numbered "(2)" -
"(2) A person shall not deliver in completion
of the transfer by sale or otherwise an animal
over the age of one week unless at the time of such
delivery there is delivered to the transferee or
his agent a certificate from the Sark Veterinary Officer
stating that the animal has been submitted to the
test in relation to Bovine Tuberculosis by that
Officer during the sixty days next
preceding the date of such delivery and that the
animal is not affected with Bovine Tuberculosis:
Provided that the provisions of this subsection
shall not apply to animals delivered for the
purpose of being slaughtered immediately after
delivery.";

- (c) subsection (2) of section twelve thereof is
repealed and the following subsection is sub-
stituted therefor -

"(2) The compensation payable, in respect of
any animal slaughtered under and in accordance
with the provisions of this Ordinance, shall,
subject to the provisions of the next succeed-
ing subsection, be -

- (a) in the case of cattle, other than
oxen, their market value immediately
before slaughter, or the amount
specified hereunder for the category

of animal in question, whichever is the less -

- (i) a milch cow, or a heifer
over six months in calf £300
- (ii) a heifer aged -
 - two years and over and which
is less than six months in
calf £200
 - two years and over and which
is not in calf ... £150
 - one and a half years and
under two years ... £130
 - one year and under one and
a half years ... £100
 - six months and under one
year £85
 - under six months ... £75
- (iii) a bull aged -
 - two and a half years and
over £300
 - two years and under two and
a half years £200
 - one and a half years and
under two years ... £130
 - one year and under one and
a half years £100
 - six months and under one
year £85
 - under six months ... £75;

(b) in the case of oxen, their value as meat.";

(d) section seventeen thereof is repealed and the following section is substituted therefor -

"17. This Ordinance may be cited as the Bovine Animal Diseases (Sark) Ordinance, 1971."

Compensation in respect of animal slaughtered before the coming into force of this Ordinance.

2. In the case of an animal slaughtered under the provisions of the principal Ordinance before the coming into force of this Ordinance and in respect of which compensation in accordance with the provisions of that Ordinance has not been paid at the date of the coming into force of this Ordinance, compensation shall be payable in respect of that animal as if this Ordinance had not been passed.

Construction.

3. This Ordinance shall be construed as one with the principal Ordinance.

Citation.

4. This Ordinance may be cited as the Bovine Animal Diseases (Amendment) (Sark) Ordinance, 1978.

Collective title.

5. This Ordinance and the principal Ordinance may be cited together as the Bovine Animal Diseases (Sark) Ordinances, 1971 and 1978.

Commencement.

6. This Ordinance shall come into force on the *fourth* day of *October*, nineteen hundred and seventy-eight.
