1976

Made 27th October, 1976.
Came into Operation 27th October, 1976.

The Bovine Animal Diseases (Amendment) Ordinance, 1976

THE STATES, on the representations of the States Committee for Agriculture, hereby order:—

1. Immediately after subsection (1) of section nine of the Bovine Animal Diseases Ordinance, 1961, as amended^(a), there is hereby inserted the following additional subsection numbered “(2)”—

Amendment to Ordinance of 1961.

“(2) A person shall not deliver in completion of the transfer by sale or otherwise an animal over the age of one week unless at the time of such delivery there is delivered to the transferee or his agent a certificate from a veterinary surgeon stating that the animal has been submitted to the test in relation to Bovine Tuberculosis by that veterinary surgeon during the sixty days next preceding the date of such delivery and that the animal is not affected with Bovine Tuberculosis:

Provided that the provisions of this subsection shall not apply to animals delivered for the purpose of being slaughtered immediately after delivery.”.

Extent. 2. This Ordinance shall apply to the Islands of Guernsey, Herm and Jethou.

Citation. 3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Bovine Animal Diseases (Amendment) Ordinance, 1976.

Collective title. 4. This Ordinance and the Bovine Animal Diseases Ordinances, 1961 to 1975, may be cited together as the Bovine Animal Diseases Ordinances, 1961 to 1976.
