**The Bovine Semen and Artificial  
Insemination (Amendment) Ordinance, 1976**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the thirtieth day of June, nineteen hundred and seventy-six, hereby order:—

1. Immediately after section eight of the Bovine Semen and Artificial Insemination Ordinance, 1957, as amended<sup>(a)</sup>, there is hereby inserted the following additional section numbered “8A”—

8A. (1) The provisions of sub-section (9) of section 4A and section 7A of this Ordinance shall not apply to any bovine animal inseminated artificially by means of imported semen from the Guernsey breed of bovines.

(2) The provisions of sub-sections (4), (5), (6), (10) and (11)

of section 4A and section 7A of this Ordinance shall not apply to the progeny of any bovine animal produced from artificial insemination involving the use of imported semen from the Guernsey breed of bovines.”.

**Citation.** 2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Bovine Semen and Artificial Insemination (Amendment) Ordinance, 1976.

**Collective title.** 3. This Ordinance and the Bovine Semen and Artificial Insemination Ordinances, 1957 to 1971, may be cited together as the Bovine Semen and Artificial Insemination Ordinances, 1957 to 1976.
