THE BOVINE SPONGIFORM ENCEPHALITIS (ALDERNEY) ORDINANCE, 1993

THE STATES OF ALDERNEY, on the representations of the States Agricultural and Fisheries Committee, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 46 of the Government of Alderney Law, 1987 (a), hereby order:—

1. The provisions of sections 2(1)(b), 2(2), 3(1), 4, 9(a), 10, 11 and 13 of the Foot and Mouth Disease (Alderney) Ordinance, 1952, as amended(b), shall, subject to the modifications set out in section 2 below, apply in relation to bovine spongiform encephalitis as they apply in relation to foot and mouth disease; and accordingly those provisions shall, subject as aforesaid, have effect as if the references therein to foot and mouth disease included references to bovine spongiform encephalitis.

Foot and mouth disease legislation to apply to BSE.

2. Section 10(2)(a) of the Foot and Mouth Disease (Alderney) Ordinance, 1952, as amended, shall have effect in its

application in relation to bovine spongiform encephalitis as if for the words "one half of such valuation" there were substituted "the whole of such valuation".

Repeal. 3. The Foot and Mouth Disease (Alderney) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1958(c) is repealed.

Citation. 4. This Ordinance may be cited as the Bovine Spongiform Encephalitis (Alderney) Ordinance, 1993.
