

## **The By-elections Ordinance, 1998**

**THE STATES**, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Article 29(3) of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948 as amended<sup>a</sup>, hereby order:-

### **Date for by-election for the office of Conseiller**

1. An election to fill the casual vacancy in the office of Conseiller arising upon the resignation of that office by Susan Mary Plant shall be held on Wednesday 8th April, 1998.

### **Provisional date for by-election for the office of People's Deputy**

2. If at the election held pursuant to section 1 of this Ordinance the person elected to the office of Conseiller was immediately preceding that election a People's Deputy, an election to fill the casual vacancy thereupon arising<sup>b</sup> shall be held on Wednesday 20th May, 1998.

### **Citation**

3. This Ordinance may be cited as the By-Elections Ordinance, 1998.
