Ordinance of the States **XXIII**
1956

Made 25th July, 1956.

Coming into Operation .. 1st September, 1956.

**The Canine and Feline Animals
(Export) Ordinance, 1956.**

THE STATES, on the representations of the States Board of Administration, hereby order:—

1. A person shall not, at a port in this Island—
 - (a) embark, attempt to embark or cause to be embarked any canine or feline animal on any vessel which commenced its voyage to this Island from, or called during its voyage to this Island at, a prohibited port if that animal is to be disembarked at a port in the United Kingdom, the Republic of Ireland, the Isle of Man, the Island of Jersey or any of the other Islands of this Bailiwick; or

(b) embark, attempt to embark or cause to be embarked any canine or feline animal on any vessel for the purpose of being disembarked at a port in the United Kingdom, the Republic of Ireland, the Isle of Man, the Island of Jersey or any of the other Islands of this Bailiwick if that vessel is due to call at a prohibited port before reaching the port of disembarkation.

2. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of an offence and liable, on conviction, to a fine not exceeding one hundred pounds.

3. In this Ordinance, unless the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them, that is to say:—

“this Island” includes the Island of Herm;

“port” includes any airport;

“prohibited port” means a port other than a port in the United Kingdom, the Republic of Ireland, the Isle of Man, the Island of Jersey or any of the other Islands of this Bailiwick;

“vessel” includes an aircraft.

4. The Ordinances set out in the first column of the Schedule to this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent set out in the second column of that Schedule.

5. This Ordinance shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey and Herm.

6. This Ordinance shall come into force on the first day of September, 1956.
