**ANTI-DUMPING AND LITTER ORDINANCE, 1949**

Whereas the States by Resolution dated May, 20<sup>th</sup>, 1949, directed that the Committee of Public Works consider and if necessary draft an Ordinance for the prohibition of unsightly dumping of rubbish etc., and whereas it is expedient to preserve the natural beauty of the Island from being spoilt by persons who negligently leave rubbish and litter about;

Now therefore, the States have approved the following Ordinance which shall come into force at once:

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Anti-Dumping and Litter Ordinance, 1949.
2. No persons shall dump or cause to be dumped any kind of rubbish, refuse or rubble on any public land, or on any private land, in a place visible from any public path or road.

Provided that the Natural Beauties Committee may grant permission for such dumping at its discretion.

3. It shall be an offence under this Ordinance to leave any rubbish or litter in any public place, or on any land to which the public have access.
4. Any person acting in contravention of this Ordinance or who knowingly permits such contravention shall be deemed to have committed an offence and, on conviction, shall be liable to a fine not exceeding Five Pounds.

- (2) omit the words, 'which shall not be less than One Pound Sterling and,'.
