Ordinance of the Chief Pleas

The Catering (Transfer of Functions) (Sark)
Ordinance, 1992

THE CHIEF PLEAS OF SARK, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 1 of the Public Functions (Transfer and Performance) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1991, hereby order:-

Transfer of functions.

1. The functions of the Tourism Committee under the Catering (Sark) Law, 1988 are transferred to the Public Health Committee.

Variation of Law.

2. In section 20(1) of the Catering (Sark) Law, 1988 in the definition of "the Committee" for "Tourism" substitute "Public Health".

Savings.

3. (1) Nothing done by or in relation to the Tourism Committee under the Catering (Sark) Law, 1988 before the commencement of this Ordinance shall be invalidated by any provision of this Ordinance.

(2) Anything in process of being done by or in relation to the Tourism Committee under the Catering (Sark) Law, 1988 immediately before the commencement of this Ordinance may be continued by or in relation to the Public Health Committee.

Citation.

4. This Ordinance may be cited as the Catering (Transfer of Functions) (Sark) Ordinance, 1992.

Commencement.

5. This Ordinance shall come into operation on the 1st October, 1992.
