**The Census (Amendment) Ordinance, 1976**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-eighth day of October, nineteen hundred and seventy-six, hereby order:—

1. Subsection (3) of section twenty of the Census Ordinance, 1976(a), is hereby repealed and the following subsections numbered “(3)” and “(4)” are hereby substituted therefor—

Amendment to Ordinance of 1976.

“ (3) The Committee shall, as soon as may be after the preparation of the census report, order the destruction of all forms of return and other confidential personal documents relating to the Census including the erasure of all data held on computer files.

(4) The Committee shall ensure that the confidential nature of any document ordered to be destroyed under the last preceding subsection shall be preserved during the process of destruc-

tion and until the document is effectively destroyed and for this purpose any destruction so ordered shall be carried out in such manner as the Committee may direct.”.

Citation. 2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Census (Amendment) Ordinance, 1976.
