THE COMPANIES (ALDERNEY) LAW (FEES) ORDINANCE, 1995

THE STATES OF ALDERNEY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sections 159 and 164 of the Companies (Alderney) Law, 1994(a), hereby order:—

1. In section 159(1) of the Companies (Alderney) Law, 1994-

- (a) in paragraph (a) for "£50" substitute "£25";
- (b) in paragraph (f) for "£25" substitute "no fee";
- (c) in paragraph (g) for "£15" substitute "no fee";

**Reduction of
certain fees
under 1994 Law.**

2. Upon the occurrence in relation to a company of any of the following events, the company or as the case may be the applicant shall pay to the Registrar the following fees:-

- (a) upon the delivery to the Registrar of a return of allotments under section 40 of the said Law, £15;
- (b) upon the delivery to the Registrar of a copy resolution under section 53 of the said Law altering the company's share capital, £15;
- (c) upon the giving of notice to the Registrar under section 54(5) of the said Law of the redemption of redeemable preference shares, £15;
- (d) for the lodging with the Registrar under section 150 of the said Law of an inspectors' report, £15;

**Other fees for
purposes of 1994
Law.**

(a) Ordres en Conseil No. XXXIV of 1994.

- (e) for the delivery by the directors under paragraph 9 of Schedule 7 to the said Law of a certificate required to be signed under paragraph 5, 6 or 8 of that Schedule, £15;
- (f) for an application to the Registrar pursuant to any provision of the said Law for the entry in the Registrar of Companies of a copy of an order of the Court made under any such provision, £15;
- (g) for the delivery to the Registrar pursuant to any provision of the said Law of a copy of a special resolution for entry in the Register of Companies, £15;
- (h) for an inspection of the Register of Companies, or of the records in respect of a company which has been struck off or otherwise dissolved, £10 per company; and, for the purposes of this paragraph, the Register and records shall be deemed to include the company's memorandum and articles, its certificate of registration, its annual returns, its special resolutions and all other documents required by law-
 - (i) to be given to the Registrar in relation to the company; or
 - (ii) to be entered by the Registrar in the Register of Companies;
- (i) for the supply by the Registrar of a photocopy of any document described in paragraph (j), £1 per A4 side (for the first five sides in respect of any one company) and 50 pence per A4 side thereafter.

- Interpretation.** 3. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948(b) shall apply to the interpretation of this Ordinance.
- Citation.** 4. This Ordinance may be cited as the Companies (Alderney) Law (Fees) Ordinance, 1995.
- Commencement.** 5. This Ordinance shall come into force on the 3rd May, 1995.
