**The Contributory Pensions
(Usual Earnings) (Increase of Limit)
Ordinance, 1961**

THE STATES, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by section two of the Contributory Pensions (Amendment) (No. 2) (Guernsey) Law, 1956, and in pursuance of their Resolution of the fifth day of July, nineteen hundred and sixty-one, and in pursuance of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:—

1. The amount of £11 per week specified in the definition of "Worker" in Article I of the Contributory Pensions Law, 1935, as amended, and such amounts specified in Articles VII and VIII of that Law are hereby varied to amounts of £12 per week. Variation of earnings limit.
2. The Contributory Pensions (Usual Earnings) (Increase of Limit) Ordinance, 1959, is hereby repealed. Repeal.

Citation. 3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Contributory Pensions (Usual Earnings) (Increase of Limit) Ordinance, 1961.

Commence-
ment. 4. This Ordinance shall come into force on the twenty-fourth day of September, nineteen hundred and sixty-one.
