**The Contributory Pensions Regulations
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1956.**

THE STATES, on the representations of the States Insurance Authority and in pursuance of the powers now vested in them under the provisions of Article VI and of Article XXI of the Contributory Pensions Law, 1935, hereby order:—

1. The amendments to the Regulations approved by the Contributory Pensions Ordinance, 1935, as amended, set out in the Regulation scheduled to this Ordinance are hereby approved.

2. This Ordinance shall come into force on the eighteenth day of March, 1956.

SCHEDULE

The Regulations approved by the Contributory Pensions Ordinance, 1935, as amended, are hereby further amended as follows:—

- (a) in section (a) of Regulation 7 thereof, the words in brackets beginning with the words “one shilling and twopence” and ending with the words “female contributor” are hereby repealed and the following words substituted therefor—

“one shilling and threepence in respect of a male contributor and sevenpence in respect of a female contributor.”;

- (b) in section (d) of Regulation 13 thereof, the figures, letters and word “ $1/5$, 9d., $8\frac{1}{2}$ d., $4\frac{1}{2}$ d., 4d., 3d., 2d., and $1\frac{1}{2}$ d.” are hereby repealed and the following figures, letters and word substituted therefor—

“ $3/2$, $2/4$, $1/7$, $1/5$, $1/2$, 9d., $8\frac{1}{2}$ d., 7d., $4\frac{1}{2}$ d., 4d., 3d., 2d. and $1\frac{1}{2}$ d.”.
