**The Contributory Pensions Regulations  
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1959**

THE STATES, in pursuance of the powers now vested in them under the provisions of Article VI and Article XXI of the Contributory Pensions Law, 1935, and in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-seventh day of May, nineteen hundred and fifty-nine, hereby order:—

1. The amendments to the Regulations approved by the Contributory Pensions Ordinance, 1935, as amended, set out in the Regulation scheduled to this Ordinance are hereby approved.

2. This Ordinance shall come into force on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and sixty.

## SCHEDULE

The Regulations approved by the Contributory Pensions Ordinance, 1935, as amended, are hereby further amended as follows:—

- (a) Regulation six and the heading thereto are hereby repealed and the following Regulation and heading substituted therefor—

“METHOD OF AND TIME FOR PAYMENT OF CONTRIBUTIONS, ETC.

6. (1) Every contribution which is payable under the provisions of the Law shall, except as herein otherwise provided, be paid by the affixing each week of a stamp to the card of the insured person in the space indicated for that purpose upon the card.

(2) An employer who is liable under the provisions of the Law to pay contributions in respect of or on behalf of an insured person employed by him shall pay those contributions at the following times, that is to say—

- (a) where he pays to the insured person wages or other pecuniary remuneration in respect of the employment of such insured person, before paying to the insured person the wages or remuneration in respect of the period for which a contribution is payable;
- (b) where he does not pay to the insured person wages or other pecuniary remuneration in respect of the employment, on the second day of employment in each week.

(3) The Authority may, if it thinks fit and subject to such terms and conditions as it may impose, approve any arrangements whereby contributions are paid at times, or in a manner, other than those prescribed in this Regulation, and any such arrangement may include provision for the payment to the Authority of such fees as may be determined by the Authority to represent the estimated additional expense in administration to the Authority, and may, as a condition of authorising the payment of any contribution at a date later than that upon which the wages or other pecuniary remuneration for any part of the period in respect of which the contributions payable are paid, require the making of such deposit of money by way of security as the Authority may approve.

(4) The provisions of these Regulations shall, subject to the provisions of the arrangements, apply to any persons affected by the arrangements, and contravention of, or failure to comply with, any requirement of the arrangements shall be deemed to be a contravention of or failure to comply with these Regulations.”;

- (b) in section (a) of Regulation seven thereof all the words beginning with the words “In the case of” and ending with the words “the following amount” are hereby deleted and the following words substituted therefor—

“In the case of the part time employment of a worker, the first employer of the week shall pay the appropriate contribution in respect of that worker for that week. The employer of a compulsory contributor, on becoming liable

to pay the appropriate contribution as respects that contributor, shall be entitled to recover by deduction from the wages of the contributor in respect of the period or part of the period to which the contribution relates the amount of the contributor's contribution for the week (one shilling and three pence in respect of a male contributor and seven pence in respect of a female contributor). The employer of a worker, on becoming liable to pay the appropriate contribution as respects that worker, shall be entitled in any week to recover by deduction as aforesaid the proportion of the employer's contribution in respect of that part of that week during which he is not the employer of that worker. The recovery last hereinbefore referred to (that is, the proportion of the employer's contribution) shall not in any week exceed the following amount:—”;

- (c) in section (c) of Regulation seven thereof the words “but not exceeding the amount represented by the stamps affixed to such card” are hereby deleted and the words “but not exceeding the amount of the contributions to the credit of the insured person on such card” are hereby substituted therefor.
