**The Coronation (Bank Holiday)
Ordinance, 1953.**

THE STATES, on the representations of the States Coronation Celebrations Committee, hereby order:—

1. The Ordinance entitled “Ordonnance relative aux Jours Fériés” made permanent on the 18th day of January, 1909, as amended, shall have effect as if, as respects 1953, immediately after the words—

“Le Lundi de la Pentecôte”,

there were inserted the words and figures—

“Le jour du Couronnement de Sa Majesté La Reine Elizabeth II”,

in Article One of that Ordinance.

2. For the purposes of the “Ordonnance contenant les Règlements pour le Greffe” of the 25th day of October, 1930, as amended, Tuesday, the 2nd day of

June, 1953, being Coronation Day, shall be a "jour de relâche".

3. The Registry of Deaths Ordinance, 1949, shall have effect, as respects 1953, as though in section two thereof, there were inserted after the words—

" Good Friday ",

the words and figures—

" Tuesday, the 2nd day of June, 1953, being Coronation Day ".
