### THE COURT OF ALDERNEY (APPOINTMENT OF JUGE DÉLÉGUÉ) ORDINANCE, 2007

THE STATES OF ALDERNEY, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 9(3) and 46 of the Government of Alderney Law, 2004(a), hereby order:-

1. (1) If, in respect of a matter which is to be heard by the Court, it appears to the Chairman of the Court that by reason of -

**Appointment of

complexity, etc.**

(a) the complexity of the issues, or

(b) the likely length of the proceedings,

the Court will not be able to deal with the matter expeditiously and in accordance with the interests of justice, he shall apply to the Bailiff to appoint a person to exercise the powers of the Court in relation to that matter.

(2) A person so appointed shall have all the powers of the Court in relation to that matter.

(3) The provisions of this Ordinance are in addition to, and not in derogation from, the powers of the Bailiff pursuant to section 9(3) of the Government of Alderney Law, 2004.

**Interpretation.** 2. (1) In this Ordinance "**the Court**" means the Court of Alderney.

(2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948(b) applies to the interpretation of this Law.

**Citation.** 3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Court of Alderney (Appointment of Juge Délégué) Ordinance, 2007.

**Commencement.** 4. This Ordinance shall come into force on the 18th July, 2007.
