The Court of Appeal (Commencement of Jurisdiction) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1964

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by subsection (1) of section thirteen, section twenty-four, and subsection (2) of section forty-seven of the Court of Appeal (Guernsey) Law, 1961(a), hereby order:—

1. The day to be appointed by Ordinance under the provisions of subsection (1) of section thirteen, section twenty-four and subsection (2) of section forty-seven of the Court of Appeal (Guernsey) Law, 1961, shall be the fourth day of June, nineteen hundred and sixty-four.

Commencement of appellate jurisdiction of the Court of Appeal in civil and criminal matters, etc.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Court of Appeal (Commencement of Jurisdiction) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1964.
