The Dangerous Drugs (Amendment) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1973

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section four and section twelve of the Dangerous Drugs (Guernsey) Law, 1966(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:—

1. The Dangerous Drugs (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1967 (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Ordinance”) (b), is hereby amended as follows:—

(a) in subsection (1) of section one thereof immediately after the definition of the expression “licensed” there is inserted the following additional definition—

““ medical prescription ” has the meaning assigned to it by subsection (2) of section five of the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Guernsey) Law, 1972;”;

(b) in subsection (3) of section sixteen thereof immediately after the word "shall" where that word secondly occurs there are inserted a comma and the words and comma "except in the case of a medical prescription,";

(c) in section twenty-five thereof immediately after the word "prescriptions" there are inserted the words "other than medical prescriptions".

Extent. 2. This Ordinance shall apply throughout the Bailiwick.

Citation and collective title. 3. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Dangerous Drugs (Amendment) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1973.

(2) This Ordinance and the principal Ordinance may be cited together as the Dangerous Drugs (Guernsey) Ordinances, 1967 and 1973.
