**The Dangerous Drugs (Guernsey) Law, 1966
(Modification) (No. 2) Ordinance, 1967**

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section thirteen of the Dangerous Drugs (Guernsey) Law, 1966(a), and of all other powers thereunto them enabling, hereby order:—

1. Part II of the Schedule to the Dangerous Drugs (Guernsey) Law, 1966, as amended, is hereby further amended as follows, that is to say:— Amendment

(a) sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph 9 thereof is hereby repealed and the following sub-paragraph is hereby substituted therefor—

“(1) A preparation of not more than one of the substances to which this paragraph applies, when compounded with one or more other ingredients and containing not more than 100 milligrammes of the substance per dosage

unit and with a concentration of not more than 2.5 per cent in undivided preparations.”;

- (b) in paragraph 10 thereof, the words “that the preparation has no, or a negligible, risk of abuse and” are hereby repealed;
- (c) in paragraph 11 thereof, the words “that the preparation has no, or a negligible, risk of abuse and” are hereby repealed;
- (d) in paragraph 12 thereof, the words “Solid dose preparations” are hereby repealed and the word “Preparations” is hereby substituted therefor.

Citation and extent.

2. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Dangerous Drugs (Guernsey) Law, 1966 (Modification) (No. 2) Ordinance, 1967.

(2) This Ordinance shall apply throughout the Bailiwick.
