**The Dangerous Drugs (Guernsey) Law,
1966 (Modification) Ordinance, 1967**

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section thirteen of the Dangerous Drugs (Guernsey) Law, 1966, and of all other powers thereunto them enabling, hereby order:—

1. The Schedule to the Dangerous Drugs (Guernsey) Law, 1966, is hereby amended as follows, that is to say:— Amendment of Schedule to Law of 1966.

(a) in paragraph 1 in Part I thereof—

- (i) the word “Acetorphine” is hereby inserted immediately before the word “Acetyldihydrocodeine”;
- (ii) the word “Dextropropoxyphene” is hereby repealed;
- (iii) the word “Etorphine” is hereby inserted immediately after the word “Etonitazene”;

- (iv) the word "Piritramide" is hereby inserted immediately after the word "Piminodine";
- (b) in sub-paragraph (2) of paragraph 9 in Part II thereof, the word "dextropropoxyphene" is hereby repealed.

Citation and extent.

2. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Dangerous Drugs (Guernsey) Law, 1966 (Modification) Ordinance, 1967.

(2) This Ordinance shall apply throughout the Bailiwick.
