**The Dangerous Drugs (Guernsey) Law,
1966 (Modification) Ordinance, 1969**

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section thirteen of the Dangerous Drugs (Guernsey) Law, 1966(a), and of all other powers thereunto them enabling, hereby order:—

1. In paragraph 1 in Part I of the Schedule to the Dangerous Drugs (Guernsey) Law, 1966, as amended, the word “Bezitramide” is hereby inserted immediately after the word “Betaprodine”. Amendment of Schedule to Law of 1966.

2. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Dangerous Drugs (Guernsey) Law, 1966 (Modification) Ordinance, 1969. Citation and extent.

(2) This Ordinance shall apply throughout the Bailiwick.
