**The Dangerous Drugs Ordinance, 1955.**

THE STATES, on the representations of the States Board of Administration and of the States Board of Health and in pursuance of the powers now vested in them by Article XI of the Law entitled "Loi ayant rapport à l'Importation, l'Exportation, la Manufacture, la Vente et l'Emploi d'Opium et d'autres Drogues Dangereuses dans les Iles du Bailliage" registered on the Records of this Island on the 7th day of March, 1931, as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:—

1. The Law entitled "Loi ayant rapport à l'Importation, l'Exportation, la Manufacture, la Vente et l'Emploi d'Opium et d'autres Drogues Dangereuses dans les Iles du Bailliage", registered on the Records of this Island on the 7th day of March, 1931, as amended, is hereby further amended by the insertion immediately after the drug numbered "(17)" in

Cédule A to that Law of the following additional drugs numbered "(18) to (20)" both inclusive—

"(18) Diethylthiambutene (3-diethylamino-1:1-di-(2-thienyl)-1-butene), its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of diethylthiambutene.

(19) 1-Methyl-4-phenylpiperidine-4-carboxylic acid isopropyl ester, its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of 1-methyl-4-phenylpiperidine-4-carboxylic acid isopropyl ester.

(20) Normethadone (4:4-diphenyl-6-dimethylamino-3-hexanone), its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of normethadone."

2. This Ordinance and the Dangerous Drugs Ordinances, 1949 to 1954, may be cited together as the Dangerous Drugs Ordinances, 1949 to 1955.
