ORDINANCE OF THE STATES

Made 22nd July, 1965
Coming into force 22nd July, 1965

THE DANGEROUS WEAPONS (ALDERNEY) LAW, 1965
(COMMENCEMENT) ORDINANCE, 1965

THE STATES, in pursuance of subsection (2) of section eleven of the Dangerous Weapons (Alderney) Law, 1965, hereby orders :-

1. The Dangerous Weapons (Alderney) Law, 1965, shall come into force on the twenty-second day of July nineteen hundred and sixty-five.
2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Dangerous Weapons (Alderney) Law, 1965, (Commencement) Ordinance, 1965.

Licensing (Amendment) Ordinance, 1952, the Alderney Liquor Licensing (Amendment) Ordinance, 1958, the Alderney Liquor Licensing (Amendment) Ordinance, 1961 and the Alderney Liquor Licensing (Amendment) Ordinance, 1964, may be cited together as the Alderney Liquor Licensing Ordinances, 1951 to 1964.

SCHEDULE

Section 11

Alderney Liquor Licensing Ordinances, 1951 to 1964

NOTICE

1. No person shall consume any intoxicating liquor in any premises in respect of which there exists a Restaurant Licence except
 - (a) during the hours of 11a.m. and 3p.m. or during the hours of 7p.m. and 12p.m. on any day, other than a Friday; and
 - (b) with a meal or as an ancillary to a meal;under penalty of a fine not exceeding five pounds for a first offence and not exceeding ten pounds for a second or subsequent offence.
2. No person under the age of eighteen years shall consume intoxicating liquor in any licensed premises and no person shall supply such liquor for consumption in any licensed premises to any person apparently under that age under the same penalty mentioned above.
