ORDINANCE OF THE STATES

Made 4th November, 1970
Coming into force 4th November, 1970

THE DECIMAL CURRENCY (ALDERNEY) ORDINANCE,
1970

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the eighth day of February, nineteen hundred and sixty-eight, hereby order:-

The new decimal currency.

1.(1) On and after the day appointed by Her Majesty's Treasury as the day on and after which, in pursuance of the provisions of the Decimal Currency Act, 1967, the denominations of money in the currency of the United Kingdom shall be the pound sterling and the new penny, the new penny being one hundredth part of a pound sterling, the legal currency of the Island of Alderney and the denominations thereof shall be the pound sterling and the said new penny.

(2) Such notes and coins as may from time to time be issued by the States of Guernsey on and after the day appointed as aforesaid shall have a value equivalent to that of corresponding notes and coins issued in the United Kingdom.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Decimal Currency (Alderney) Ordinance, 1970.
