Ordinance of the Chief Pleas

The Deputies of the People (Bye-Election) Ordinance, 2002

THE CHIEF PLEAS OF SARK, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section twelve of the Reform (Sark) Law, 1951, hereby order: -

(1) An election for the Office of Deputy of the People left vacant by Deputy David Curtis purchasing a tenement and by the resignation of Deputy Jeremy La Trobe-Bateman, shall be held on Wednesday the 8th day of May 2002.

(2) In the event of two or more candidates at the said election securing an equal number of votes and by reason thereof a further election being required to be held in pursuance of the provisions of section five of the Election of Deputies (Sark) Ordinance, 1952, as amended, in respect of such candidates only without further nomination, such further election shall be held on Wednesday 22nd May 2002.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Deputies of the People (Bye Election) Ordinance, 2002.
